Be a headquarters for helping young shooters earn their shotgunning and riflery patches in the Junior USA Shooting Team Patch Program.

Riflery Patch Rules

1. Allow youngsters under adult supervision to shoot a total of five shots at the target on the back of this poster, or a copy of that target, and reach a minimum score of 35 points.
2. If the youth is shooting a BB gun, set the target 15 feet from the shooting station. If he or she is shooting an air gun, set out the target 33 feet. If they are shooting a .22 rifle, set the target 50 feet away.
3. The supervising adult must score and sign the target.

Shotgunning Patch Rules

1. Allow youngsters under adult supervision, using a copy of the shotgunning score sheet on this page, to shoot a regulation round of trap or skeet.
2. To earn a shotgunning patch, the youth must shoot a complete round of trap or skeet and earn a minimum score of seven broken targets.
3. Copies of the score sheet may be used for practice until a qualifying score is achieved.
4. The supervising adult must sign the score sheet.

Targets & Score Sheet

1. Make copies of the target on the back of this poster and the score sheet below, or...
2. ...Go to www.nssf.org/JrUSA and click on "Bull's-Eye Target" and "Score Sheet" to print copies.

Obtaining the Patches

1. Provide instant recognition to your new recruits by ordering a supply of patches in advance. For advance orders, log on to www.nssf.org/jrusa and provide the requested information under the "Adult Leaders—order patches online" link. NSSF will ship orders as they are received, but delivery may take up to six weeks. After the shoot, simply fill out a report form and return it to NSSF to help track the success of the program.
2. If you are eager to get started, begin the shooting today and then log on to www.nssf.org/jrusa and order patches for your participants by clicking the "Adult Leaders—order patches online" link. You will need the first and last name of your participants and their individual scores to complete your order.
3. Finally, if an individual would like to earn his or her patch at your range, they can order their patch online by filling out a simple form at www.nssf.org/jrusa, or by sending their target or score sheet to Junior USA Team 2008, c/o NSSF, 11 Mile Hill Road, Newtown, CT 06470-2359.

BASIC RULES OF TRAP SHOOTING: Squads of up to five individuals shoot single targets from fixed positions. These five positions are called stations and are three yards apart. The stations are positioned in an arc behind the trap house, and each individual takes one shot in turn until each shooter has taken five shots. After completing five shots each shooter moves to the next station, and so on, until all positions have been used, for a total of 25 shots per round. Clay disks are thrown from the trap house on the command, "Pull," and travel more than 40 mph. Shooters never know the angle of the target until it is released. Each station offers a new challenge as targets fly in a variety of angles in relation to the shooter.
